OUR OBJECTIONS TO THE PLANNING APPLICATION

Well, if you thought the overnight results of the Euro elections were big news; wait 'til you hear this! The close date for objections was Friday and, by the end of the "poll" we had the following result:

AGAINST (That's us): **551**

FOR (That's them): **11** *(including 8 photocopied letters, which apparently don't count).*

We couldn't get Nick Robinson to do a deeper analysis for you (he was elsewhere today) so here is some more in-depth information, put together by one of the HHAG team.

There were 551 individual objections. Some of those were from different people living at the same address, but even so there were still 482 objections, by household.

Letters supporting the travellers were 11 in total (all from Aylesbury, funnily enough) and only three were "real" letters; the rest were just photocopies. I'm led to believe that the council will not count these as they are treated as "a petition".

We had objection letters from 11 local authorities and voluntary bodies.

Many people contacted us to say that they either couldn't get onto the WDC web site or, if they did, the system wouldn't let them put in their objection. We have passed their comments on to Charles Power at WDC.

Thank you all for your efforts. If this doesn't show the council how we all feel, then who knows what will?!

As mentioned in the last newsletter, we don't know how long the council will take over their deliberations, but we will do our best to give you any clues we pick up as to timing.

Please give yourselves a well-deserved pat on the back and, if the recession allows, perhaps crack open a bottle of bubbly this evening!!
